Keeping our docs, staff and patients safe is our top priority. We have implemented changes that exceed CDC guidelines. Here is a partial list of things we are doing to help keep everyone best protected.

- 1. As a Non-Covid Care Facility, entry is only granted upon passing a screening questionnaire and temperature check.
- Occupancy will be limited to Dr. Bazan, Aaron, and the scheduled patient (and 1 guardian as needed). Each appointment will be slotted for a full 30 minutes.
- 3. Properly worn masks are mandatory for everyone at all times. Dr. Bazan and Aaron will be using n95 respirators. Other types of PPE will be utilized as appropriate.
- 4. Hand sanitizing upon entry and as requested is mandatory.
- 5. As always, equipment will be disinfected before each patient.
- 6. Exam rooms will be disinfected with germicidal UVC light between patients.
- 7. Exam rooms will have HEPA and germicidal UVC light filtered air.
- 8. Ozone disinfection of the entire office will be done nightly.
- 9. Frames will be wiped clean then disinfected with germicidal UVC light after they are tried on.
- 10. As always, general office cleaning/disinfection will be done throughout the day.
